About Your New Plan:

Important Things to Know:

- You must be enrolled in Medicare Parts A and B to participate in the Aetna® MAPD plan.
- Put your Medicare card in a safe place in case you need it later. You will use only your Aetna® ID card for Medical and Prescription Drug coverage.
- You can use any willing Medicare medical provider, regardless of if the provider is in or out of the Aetna® network.
- No referrals are needed for Medicare covered medical services.

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- You should continue to be able to use almost any retail pharmacy as Aetna® includes over 65,000 in-network pharmacies, nationwide.
- You do not need new prescriptions for retail pharmacies. Simply show your new ID card and your refills will be processed under the Aetna® MAPD plan.
- Your vision and dental coverage will continue to be through VSP Vision and Delta Dental through the fund.
- Medical Prior Authorizations are needed with this plan. We recommend you contacting RetireeFirst if you have an upcoming medical service or procedure.

We are required by law to give you the choice of opting out of the new plan. Since you are currently enrolled in the NASI Welfare Fund Medical and Prescription Drug plan it is unlikely that you would not be able to participate in the new robust Aetna® MAPD plan. However, you have the option to opt-out. If you opt out, you will not have medical and prescription coverage through NASI Welfare Fund.
