RetireeFirst received notification from IATSE Local 22/772 that you will soon be eligible for Medicare, and as a result, should be enrolled into the Cigna True Choice Medicare Advantage with Prescription Drug Plan. RetireeFirst and IATSE Local 22/772 are excited to offer this comprehensive Medicare Advantage and Prescription Drug (MAPD) plan to you and/or your dependents, in addition to the added benefit of having access to RetireeFirst Advocates.

To finalize your enrollment into the Cigna True Choice Medicare Advantage with Prescription Drug Plan, the enclosed application will need to be completed and returned to RetireeFirst in the included pre-paid envelope.

RetireeFirst Advocates are US-based and available to help you navigate the complex retiree healthcare landscape and troubleshoot any issues you may have with your insurance carrier, provider's office, and pharmacy.

About Your New Plan:

Important Things to Know:

- You must be enrolled in Medicare Parts A and B to participate in the Cigna MAPD Plan.
- Put your Medicare card in a safe place in case you need it later. You will use only your Cigna ID card for Medical and Prescription Drugs.
- You can use any willing Medicare medical provider, regardless of if the provider is in or out of the Cigna network.
- No referrals are needed for Medicare covered medical services.
- You should continue to be able to use almost any retail pharmacy as Cigna includes over 66,000 in-network pharmacies, nationwide.



- Cigna also offers a Mail Order Pharmacy called Express Scripts for your convenience. If you would like to use the Express Scripts Mail Order Pharmacy, you will need new prescriptions.
- You do not need new prescriptions for retail pharmacies. Simply show your new ID card and your refills will be processed under the Cigna MAPD Plan.
