#### The Age-In Process

Age-ins refer to individuals who will become Medicare eligible and have the opportunity to transition from active employer- or union-sponsored health coverage to a Medicare-based plan.

Retirees who don't transition into Medicare during their seven-month Initial Enrollment Period may be subject to penalties and delayed access to healthcare.

For Group Medicare plan sponsors, the age-in process is equally critical. Many early retirees remain on the active employee plan, which is often more expensive for the plan sponsor. Transitioning these retirees to a Medicare-based plan not only aligns with regulatory requirements, but also helps reduce costs while continuing quality healthcare coverage.
